


Palm Desert Visitor Services

Palm Desert Visitor Services annually provides in-person information to 6,572 people at City Hall. Though not ideal, this location has been sufficient for the past eight years.

Discussion about the future home of Palm Desert Visitor Services has recently focused on the new Library building currently in the pre-planning phase. One of the many advantages of housing Visitor Services at the library includes the ability to assist visitors seven days a week.



What's Being Proposed

The renovation of the current library building planned for May/June offers an excellent opportunity to move Visitor Services to the existing library as it becomes a City facility.
