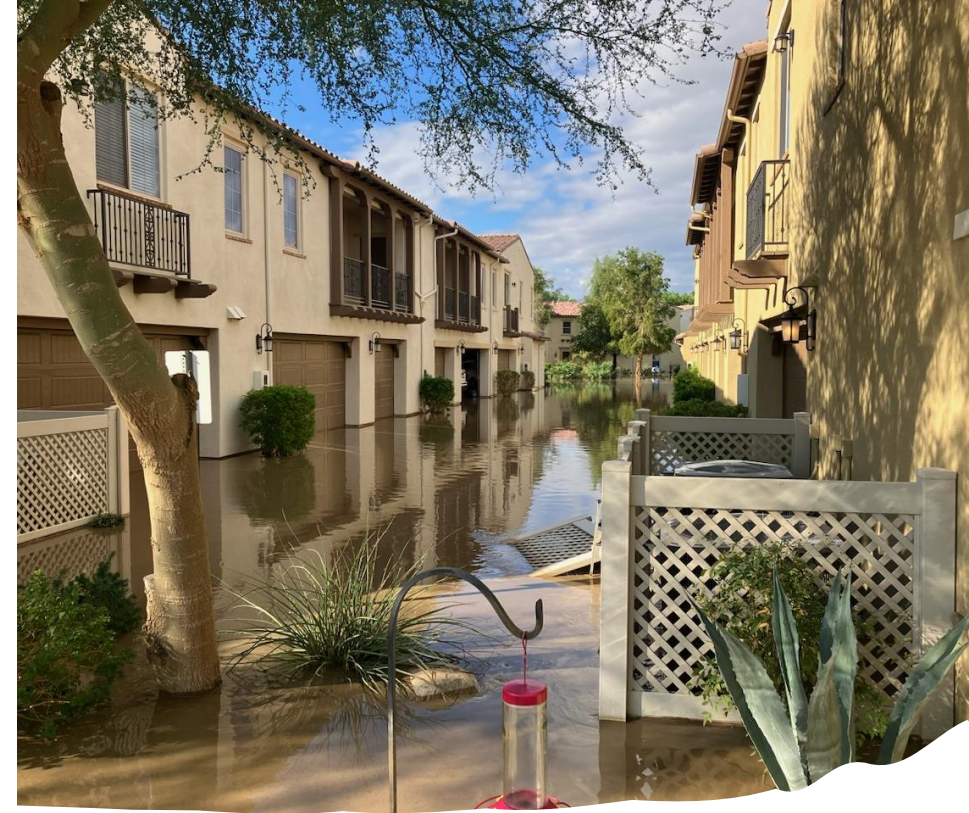

Staff is currently working with insurance and consultants researching and evaluating the following:

- Replacement costs for various losses throughout city
- Reconstruction of any failed or underbuilt systems
- Potential need for acquisition or construction of additional infrastructure/facilities to accommodate similar storm systems
- Outdated policies and/or codes in place to mitigate future issues
- Opportunities to reimburse City for cleanup and replacement costs
- Coordination of potential regional efforts
