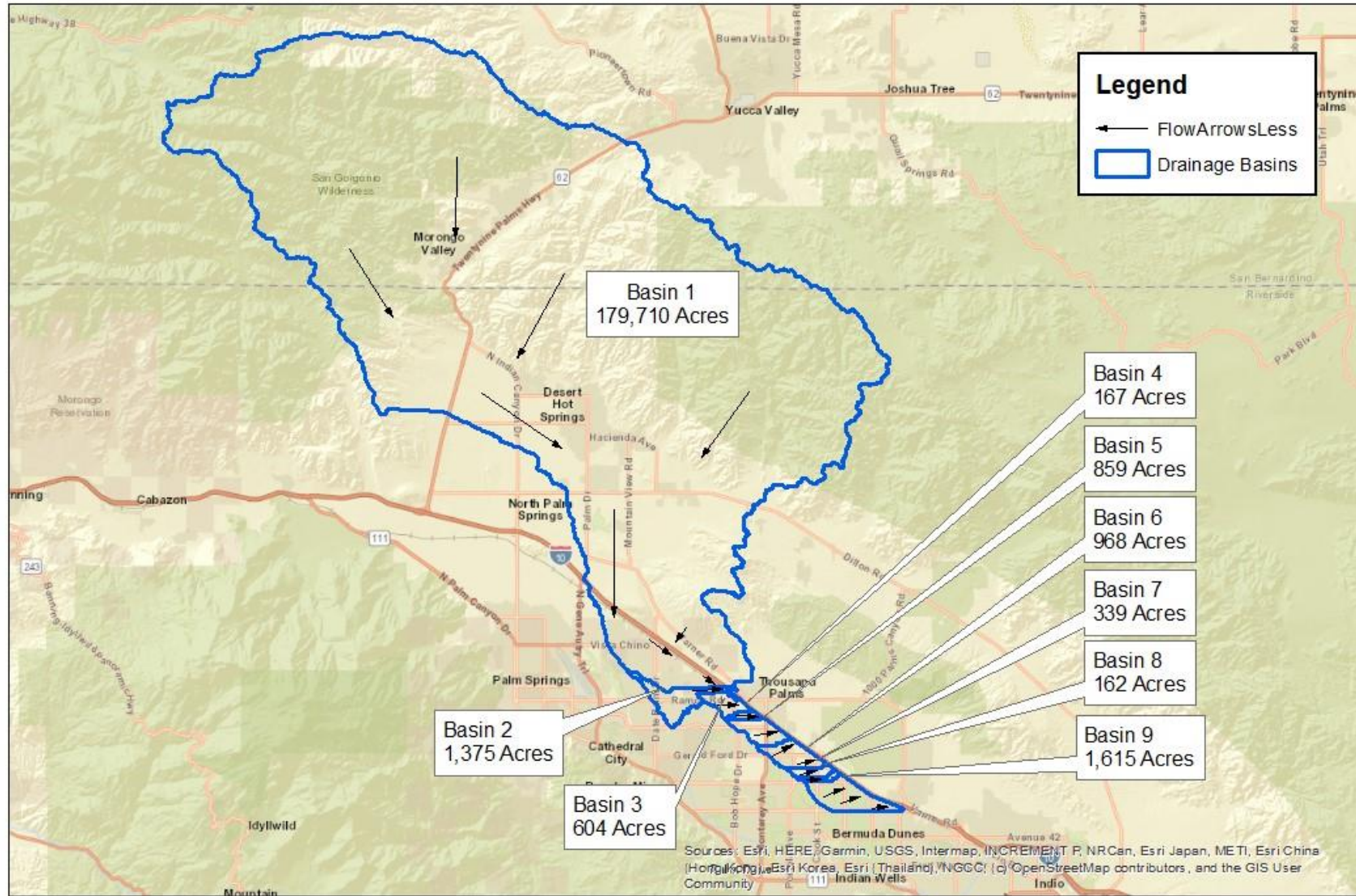

TROPICAL STORM HILARY

Storm Recovery: Spanish Walk

- Performed about \$175,000 of cleanup activities
- FEMA did not cover private property damages
- Most properties did not have flood insurance
- Other commercial property owners & HOAs have requested similar assistance



Storm Recovery: Desilt Channels & Repair Basins

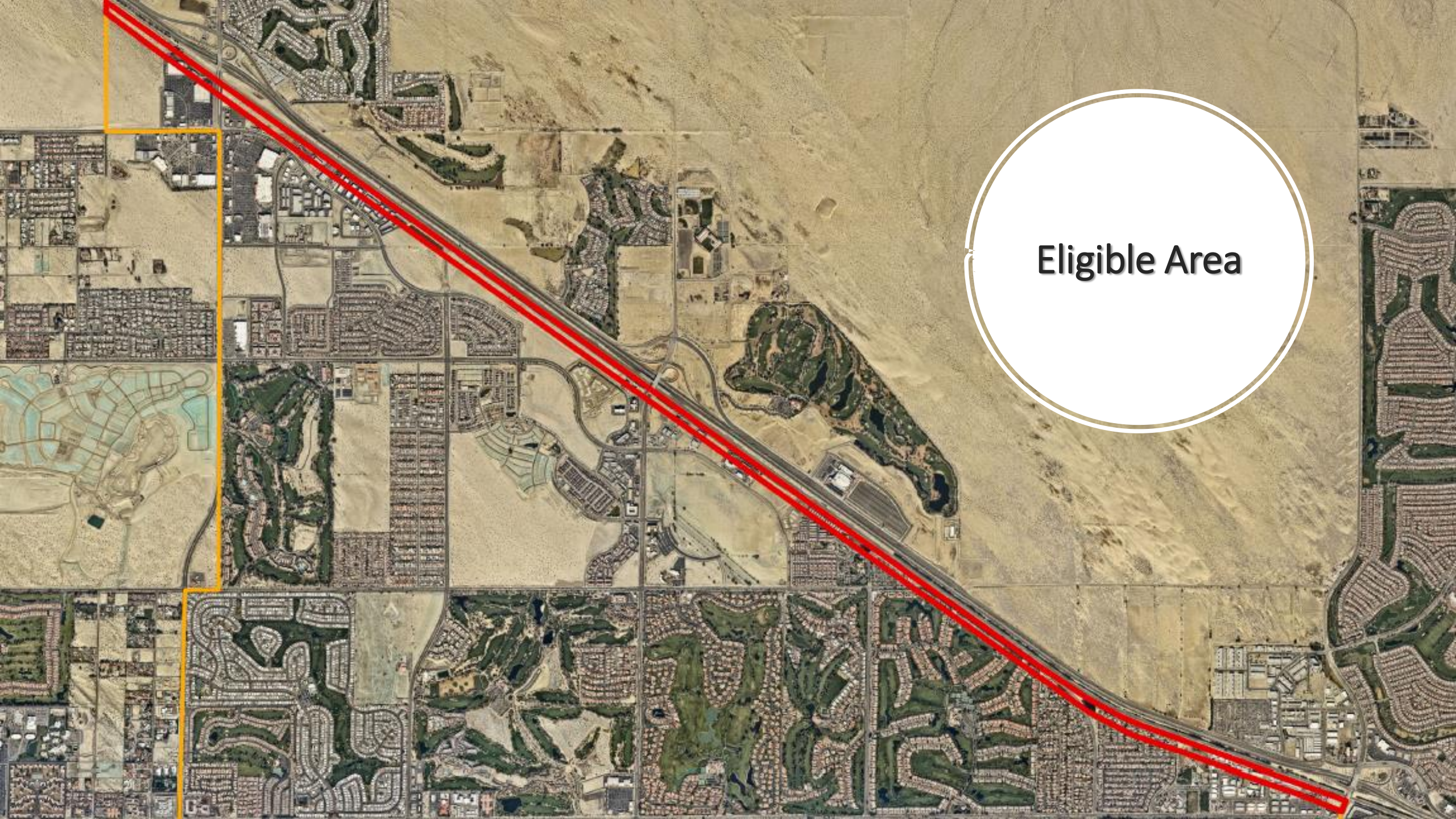
- Repair drainage infrastructure & remove debris underway (North Palm Desert)
- Work ongoing to drain & desilt basins east of Cook Street
- Debris & silt still present on properties & drainage systems – ***why important?***
 - Properties use basins & impact storm drains & channels if not maintained properly
 - Debris in storm drains limit the effectiveness of the City's drain system & cause flooding





Storm Recovery: Proposed Grant Program

- Purpose:
 - Assist with cleanup activities for storm drain systems & debris removal that serve broader public interests & needs
- Total Program Budget: \$1,500,000
- Award Per Property:
 - Up to \$200,000 (35% match)
 - Reimbursement basis
 - Not retroactive
 - Prevailing wage (under \$15,000 exempt)
- Coverage Area: 250' south of I-10 (Miriam Wy. to Washington St.)
- Eligible Properties:
 - Commercial property owners
 - Homeowners associations (HOAs)
- Ineligible Properties:
 - Residential property owners
 - Commercial property tenants
 - Previously assisted commercial properties & HOAs
