As a part of our ongoing efforts to enhance our community's active transportation infrastructure, we invite you to participate in upcoming community engagement events taking place in your neighborhood regarding the City's Walk & Roll project. This project aims to create safer and more accessible sidewalks throughout Palm Desert, aligning with the objectives in the City's General Plan.

The following streets have been identified for improvement:

- **San Juan Drive & Fairhaven Drive** from Parkview to Fred Waring
- **San Gorgonio Way** from Monterey to San Pablo
- **De Anza Way** from San Pablo to Portola
- **Catalina Way** from San Pablo to Portola
- **San Pascual Avenue** from Alessandro to Fred Waring

These improvements will require changes to the public right-of-way, including the removal of landscaping and fencing and/or modifications to the on-street parking. To ensure that all affected residents are well-informed and have scheduled opportunities for you to provide input, in your neighborhood.
