SCOPE OF WORK



PROJECT DESCRIPTION



- Add sidewalks throughout the area to increase pedestrian connectivity and mobility
- Sidewalks would be added to one side of the street only
- Areas identified already have sidewalks improvements to some extent
- Crosswalks are part of the proposed improvements

COMMUNITY MEETINGS/OUTREACH

- ATP Meeting held on February 29th at Council Chambers
- Community Meetings held on site at 6 pm:
 - April 9th at 43822 Fairhaven Drive at Vista Bonita
 - April 10th at 73750 Catalina Way, Outside the Joslyn Center
 - April 16th at 44550 San Carlos Avenue, Palma Village Park
- Staff estimates around 50+ residents participated



COMMUNITY FEEDBACK

Fairhaven Meeting:

- Residents on/near San Juan Drive strongly oppose the addition of a sidewalk in their area and requested that it be removed from our scope of work.
- Expressed concerns over speeding in the area

Joslyn Center Meeting:

- Majority approved the addition of sidewalks
- Residents expressed that the project should leave them whole or compensate them for the removal of landscaping

San Pablo Park Meeting:

- Majority approved the addition of sidewalks
- Preference to keep on street parking
- Expressed concerns over speeding in the area

RECOMMENDATION

Based on the Community Feedback received, staff request the approval of the following recommendations:

Proceed with the Walk and Roll PD Phase 3 Project with the following considerations:

- Exclude the addition of sidewalk on San Juan Drive
- Coordinate the reinstallation of fences/landscaping (where needed)
- Evaluate and implement traffic calming measures (where possible)
 - Narrow the streets
 - Speed Cushions
 - Speed Feedback Signs
 - Stop Sign
 - Rapid Flashing Beacons at crosswalks
