Chapter 24.16 Outdoor Lighting provides definition for decorative lighting, but no guidance on standards or process:

<u>Decorative Lighting</u>. Lighting products used for decorative effects versus lighting performance. Examples of decorative lighting include, but are not limited to, fountain lighting, lighting fixtures (pole, post or bollard style) creating a visual effect with low lumen output, led commercial outdoor string lighting, building wall sconce and chandelier lighting with low lumen lamp sources."

Architectural outdoor lighting requirements: Lighting used to highlight architectural features, landscape, building façades, fountains, etc., shall be manufactured for the intended uses and shall be adjusted and/or aimed during the night to insure light is focused on the designated object.



Section 25.68.020 has required ARC Design Review for tube lighting: "No plan, elevation for buildings or structures, or alterations shall be approved and no permit shall be issued for any building, structure, sign, or other development [...] without review and approval by the ARC."
