Please review my written statements listed below prior to the consideration of agenda Item: 14.c

Position: In agreement with City's recommendation

It's highly recommended to voice concerns over South Coast Air Quality District (SCAQMD) radical position to impose additional restrictions throughout Southern California communities.

It's been repeatedly demonstrated that SCAQMD have been able to gain influence over most governmental agencies within its authority (boundaries).
