Grant Activity Update

Federal Earmarks - FY 2026

- Senator Alex Padilla has selected the City's Emergency Resiliency Plan request for federal funding in the amount of \$843,000.
- Congressman Ken Calvert has selected the Cook Street Bridge project for federal funding in the amount of \$5,670,544.
