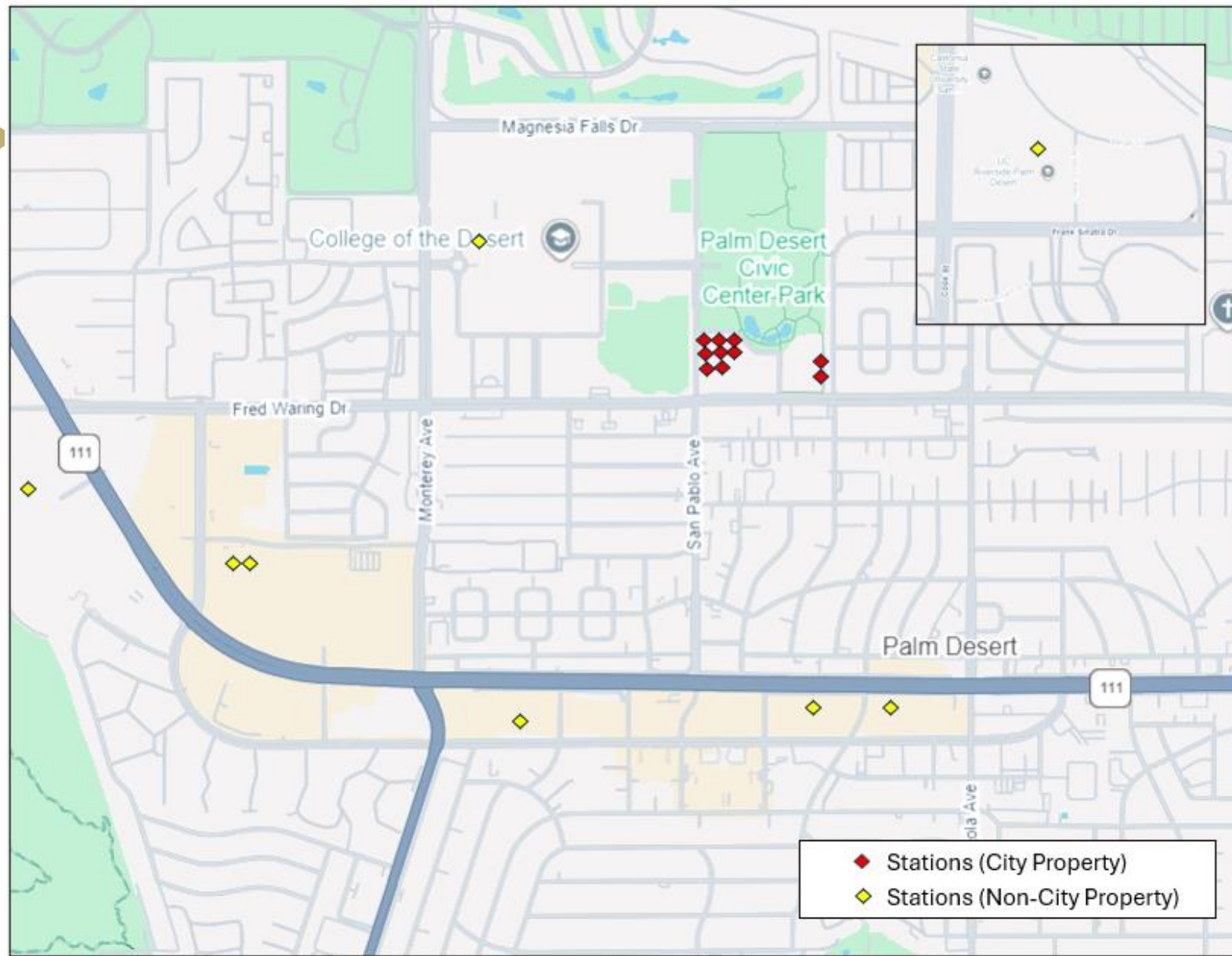

Charging Stations: Inventory

- **How many stations?**
 - Total: 18
- **Are the stations free or paid?**
 - Free: 17
 - Paid: 1
- **Are the stations operable?**
 - Operable: 15
 - Inactive/needs repairs: 3

RFP: Committee Comments



The City should not pay for electricity.



The City should not pay for installation & maintenance costs.



The City should not be responsible for charging on Non-City property.

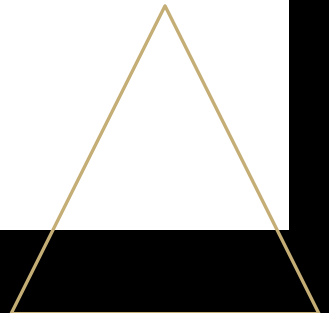


The City should not advertise on charging stations.



Recommendations

- Terminate Existing Agreements & Responsibilities.
 - Property owners assume responsibility, or City restores sites to previous condition.
 - Existing stations remain in service until an alternate program is established.
- Develop a Site License Program to replace EV charging stations.
 - Enable private vendors to install, operate & maintain EV charging stations.
 - Turnkey operation funded at the vendor's expense.
 - Applies to City-owned or managed property (Presidents' Plaza I-II & III).
