

**AMENDMENT NO. 3 TO THE PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT  
BY AND BETWEEN THE CITY OF PALM DESERT  
AND ACCENTURE, LLP**

**1. Parties and Date.**

This Amendment No. 3 (“Amendment”) to the Professional Services Agreement, Contract No. C44810, is made and entered into on **September 16, 2025**, by and between the City of Palm Desert, a municipal corporation organized under the laws of the State of California with its principal place of business at 73-510 Fred Waring Drive, Palm Desert, California, 92260-2578 (“City”) and **Accenture LLP, through its disregarded entity Accenture Infrastructure and Capital Projects, LLC, a Limited Liability Company, with its principal place of business at 300 Spectrum Center Dr., Floor 14, Irvine, California, 92618 Consultant**). City and Consultant are sometimes individually referred to as “Party” and collectively as “Parties.”

**2. Recitals.**

- 2.1 Agreement. The City and Consultant entered into a Professional Services Agreement dated February 16, 2023 (“Agreement”), for the purpose of retaining the services of Consultant for On-Call Construction Management Services (“Project”).
- 2.2 Background. The parties previously entered into two previous amendments, one of which was erroneously titled amendment No. 1, resulting in duplicate amendment No.1’s.
- 2.3 Amendments. The previous amendments were entered into on February 3, 2025, and August 12, 2025, one to extend the term of the Agreement and the other to update Consultants legal entity name, respectively. The City and Consultant now desire to amend the Agreement to memorialize, consolidate, and correct the amendments previously entered into between the parties.
- 2.4 Amendment Authority. This Amendment is authorized pursuant to Section 3.6.14 of the Agreement.
- 2.5 Amendment No. 3. The purpose of this Amendment No. 3 is to memorialize, consolidate, and correct the understanding between the parties regarding the amendments entered into on February 3, 2025, and August 12, 2025. For the avoidance of doubt, it shall be memorialized and understood that the Amendment dated August 12, 2025, shall be legally known as Amendment No. 2, not Amendment No. 1 as entitled.

**3. Terms.**

- 3.1 Continuing Effect of Agreement. Except as amended by this Amendment No.

**Contract No. C44810**

3, all other provisions of the Agreement remain in full force and effect and shall govern the actions of the Parties under this Amendment No. 3. From and after the date of this Amendment No. 3, whenever the term "Agreement" appears in the Agreement, it shall mean the Agreement as amended by this Amendment No. 3.

3.2 Adequate Consideration. The Parties hereto irrevocably stipulate and agree that they have each received adequate and independent consideration for the performance of the obligations they have undertaken pursuant to this Amendment No. 3.

3.4 Severability. If any portion of this Amendment No. 3 is declared invalid, illegal, or otherwise unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the remaining provisions shall continue in full force and effect.
