REQUEST: APPROPRIATE FUNDS FOR EMERGENCY EXPENDITURES

INCURRED DURING THE AUGUST 2023 WEATHER EVENT

### **RECOMMENDATION:**

1. Receive and file the report of expenditures to date related to the August 2023 weather event.

- 2. Appropriate funds in the amount of \$1,765,000 from committed general fund balance allocated to emergency reserves to the emergency expenditure account (1104159-4219100) to cover expenditures incurred during the August 2023 weather event.
- 3. Authorize the City Manager to transfer funds from the emergency expenditure account to other expenditure accounts as appropriate.

#### **BACKGROUND/ANALYSIS:**

The August 2023 weather event required the immediate assistance of various vendors during and after the event. Under the direction of the City Manager, staff took immediate action to procure needed services to protect life and property as authorized by the emergency declaration. Due to the unanticipated nature of the emergency, funds were not appropriated in the current budget. This action will provide appropriations to cover the immediate need to pay vendors in a timely manner. The following is a list of vendors who provided various supplies and services in support of emergency operations, as well as an estimate of costs that are expected to be incurred as a result of the response to the weather event.
